OPFFA Graphic Licence Plate Criteria

The following criteria have been adopted by the OPFFA Executive Board regarding the accessibility/entitlement of OPFFA Graphic licence plates.

- The applicant must be a current active member within the OPFFA in good standing as determined by the Local Association
- Only the vehicle(s) registered in the name of the aforementioned member will be eligible for an OPFFA graphic plate – plates shall not be transferable to any other person
- Retired fire fighters who remain a member in good standing with their local and their local is affiliated with the OPFFA (at the time of applying) shall be eligible to purchase an OPFFA graphic plate
- Eligible fire fighters may attach an OPFFA graphic plate to a vehicle currently registered to a different individual or company (i.e. leased vehicle). However, the graphic plates must be issued in the fire fighter's name. The vehicle portion of the ownership will show the vehicle owner's name (the leasing company), but the plate portion of the ownership must show the fire fighter's name
- The current local President shall be required to sign off on the attached application form of the active or retired member who meets the above criteria.
- Any member active or retired will be required to submit a completed Application, Transfer of Liability form, and payment to the OPFFA office for approval at the following:

- Once the paperwork has been approved the graphic licence plate will be forwarded to the member as per the process adopted by the OPFFA Executive Board.

Further, the definition of an OPFFA local shall include any local from the former OPFFA or PFOFF who no longer exist and are currently affiliated with the OPFFA.
