



OPFFA Graphic Licence Plate

Frequently Asked Questions

1. How much is an OPFFA graphic plate?

Currently - \$82.15 inclusive + shipping & handling charge

Total: \$100.00

2. How can I order an OPFFA graphic plate?

- You must be an active or retired member in good standing with the OPFFA.
- You must complete the application form and have it signed by your current Local President. Applications and all other paperwork can be downloaded at t www.opffa.org – see link to Graphic Plate Program.
- The application, Transfer of Liability forms, and cheque for the plate must be submitted to the OPFFA office.

3. Can I order more than one plate?

Yes - but only to vehicles registered to the member

4. What will be on the plate? –

Logo (see above), 2 numbers, PF (professional firefighter), 2 numbers
What order? Plates start at 01PF01 and progress sequentially to 99PF99

5. Can I order a personalized plate with this graphic?

No personalized plates are available under any new Graphic Licence Plate program at this time. It is expected that personalized plates will become available once the entire review of the new program has been completed by the Ministry (***this being said the OPFFA will make every effort to accommodate a specific numbering sequence request by a member i.e. 02PF34 should it be available.***)

6. Can these plates be ordered for motorcycles?

Due to space limitations, no graphics appear on motorcycle plates.

7. When will the plates be available for purchase?

The OPFFA Graphic Plate Program was launched on October 6, 2008 at the Dr. Eric Taylor Educational Seminar in Niagara Falls. After the seminar OPFFA Graphic Plates will be available at through the OPFFA office (see details on the OPFFA website – www.opffa.org)

8. After I receive the plate what do I need to do?

You need to take the plate, MTO letter (which accompanies the plate), and vehicle ownership information to a MTO office to attach your plate to your vehicle. Locations of Driver and Vehicle Licence Issuing Offices are available at <http://www.mto.gov.on.ca/english/dandv/officeloc.htm>

9. If my plate were to be damaged or stolen can I get it replaced? Will it be the same as the original?

If your plates have been lost, stolen or damaged, bring the following into a Driver and Vehicle Licence Issuing Office:

- Replacement Declaration filled out by the owner and the police or telephone reporting - the name of the officer who took the report and the occurrence number are required (not required if both plates are being returned).
- Replacement Declaration forms are available at any Driver and Vehicle Licence Issuing Office or local police department; the remaining plate if you have it; name of your insurance company and policy number; the vehicle permit (plate and vehicle portions);
- Application for Registration completed and signed by the vehicle owner

Cost to replace graphic plate set \$55.45 (HST included).

10. Will the plate be available for retired fire fighters?

Yes, you must be a retired member in good standing and from a local that is currently affiliated with the OPFFA and complete the same application form to be signed by the current local President as stated in question # 2.
